WEST VIRGINIA Adds VPP and Ancillary to Exemption

UPDATE: This expanded exemption law is now in effect.

West Virginia House Bill 4149, adds **Vehicle Protection Product** Warranties (not limited to anti-theft devices) to the state's current exemption law. Also added to the definition of an exempt service contract were ancillary benefits such as **tire/wheel/road hazard, paintless dent repair, windshield crack repair**, among others.

This legislation became effective on **May 27, 2020**.
